With these motivates University has established Six Centers which are as follows-

1. **Moot court committee (MCC)**- This committee helps the students in understanding the practical side in legal profession and also encourages students to participate in various inter and intra National Moot Court Competitions.
2. **Center for Legal Aid Program (CLAP)**- This center organizes various legal aid camps and awareness programs related to various laws within Jharkhand
3. **Tribal Rights Center**- This center caters to review the tribal laws and spread awareness among the tribal for the better understanding of laws which are meant for them.
4. **Center for Study and Research in Intellectual Property Rights (CSRIPR)** – This center concentrates upon spreading information and awareness to the students in the field of intellectual property rights
5. **Human Rights Initiative and Defenders Advocate for You (HRIDAY)**- This center caters the needs of society for protecting and defending human rights violations
6. **Internship and Placement Committee (IPC)**– This center has been established with the object of providing internship and placements to the students of law.

In addition to these centers the University also runs a quarterly newsletter and half yearly journal wherein not only the new developments in the legal education are portrait but also the various events organized by the university are showcased.

National University of study and Research in Law, Ranchi has also planned to step in to initiate a Distance Education Programme, designed to update knowledge and skills through e-learning and regular contact classes which will not only be

We have also invited Dr. KN Chaturvedi who was former secretary to the Ministry of Law and Justice, Government of India and attorneys, associates and partners from firms of repute such as Amarchand Mangal Das, Lakshmi Kumaran and Sridharan and

others. Some of our alumni who have acquired higher qualifications from prestigious institutions and garnered varied experience share their learning on topics of contemporary interest in law and practice for the benefit of the students.

We have faculty which provides meaningful inputs in exposing students to practical facets of law. At the undergraduate level University offers Five-year Integrated BA LLB(Hons.) Degree Program which consists of ten semesters. The University commenced its Research Program in January 2012. The process for admitting students to its LLM (one year) and PhD (Two years) is already going on through Entrance Test, Group Discussion and Viva-voce. Within a span of very Short Time the University has considerably spread its academic wings and has established its outreach in the country and abroad.

(vi) Criteria for Reservation for the Admission Seats of Jharkhand:

As per NUSRL, Ranchi Act 2010:

"Fifty percent of the total seats of a particular discipline of study shall be reserved for residents of Jharkhand State or those who have passed the qualifying examination from the institutions located in Jharkhand State and to the wards of the Employees of the Central/State Government/ University/Public Undertaking/Corporations/ Boards/Academies, etc. working in Jharkhand State. Reservation policy in this regard shall be applicable for admission against these seats."

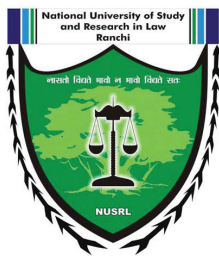
